

AN AGREEMENT made the *Ninth* day of
February One thousand nine hundred and eighty
three BETWEEN THE BRITISH RAILWAYS BOARD ('the
Board') of the one part and THE OXFORD CITY COUNCIL ('the
Council') of the other part _____

WHEREAS :-

- (1) The Board is seised in fee simple in possession free from incumbrances (with other property) of the piece of land adjoining the River Thames or Isis in the City of Oxford shown edged blue on the plan annexed hereto _____
- (2) The Board for the consideration hereinafter mentioned has consented and agreed to give up the said land to the public so that the same may be used for the purpose of public open space _____
- (3) This Agreement is entered into in pursuance of the provisions of sections 9 and 10 of the Open Spaces Act 1906

NOW IT IS HEREBY AGREED as follows:-

1. In consideration of the sum of ten pounds (£10) paid by the Council to the Board (the receipt whereof the Board hereby acknowledges) and of the agreement on the part of the Council hereinafter contained the Board as Beneficial Owner HEREBY GIVES UP AND DEDICATES to the public for the purpose aforesaid ALL THAT piece of land (the land') containing 813 square yards or thereabouts adjoining the River Thames or Isis in the City of Oxford and being more particularly delineated and edged with the colour blue on the said plan TO THE INTENT that the land shall be under the care management and control of the Council as an open space RESERVING UNTO the Board and its successors in title the right at any time to disturb the surface of the land for the purposes of inspecting maintaining or

altering the Board's railway bridge situate over the land the Board or their successors in title as soon as practicable making good any damage caused to the land by such disturbance _____

2. The Council hereby agree with the Board that the Council shall within twenty four months of the date of this Agreement erect and at all times thereafter maintain free of expense to the Board metal railings between the points marked A - B C - D and E - F on the said plan _____

3. For the avoidance of doubt the Board hereby agree with the Council that the Council may at its own expense construct a footpath network along the River Thames or Isis _____

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the transaction hereby effected does not form part of a larger transaction or of a series of transactions in respect of which the amount or value or the aggregate amount or value of the consideration exceeds twenty five thousand pounds _____

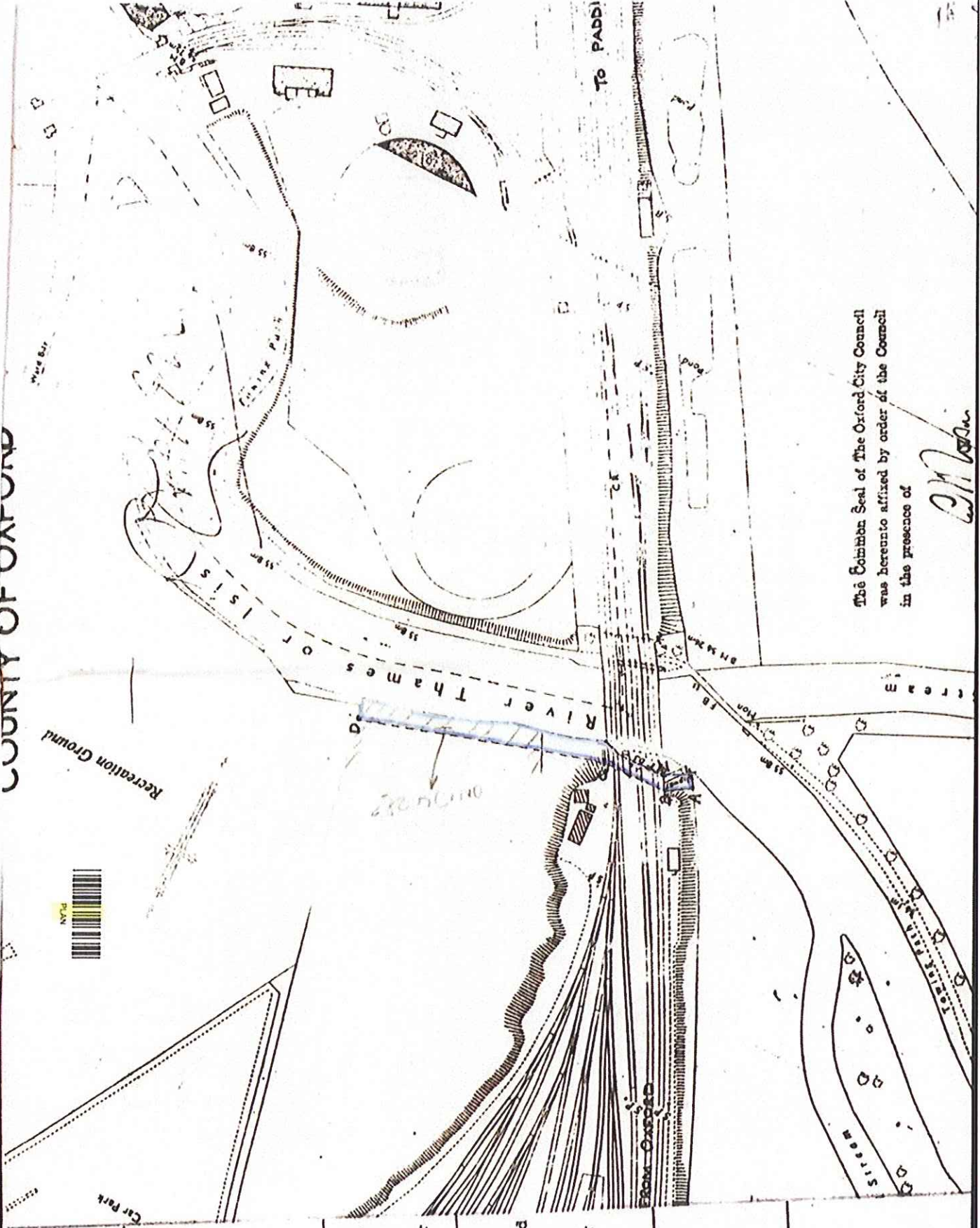
